Meetinghouse Moment #77

On May 26, 1819, Thomas F. Bishop, clerk and ACC founder, purchased the flagon (Sheffield silver plate) and four cups from Ward and Bartholomew in Hartford, and donated them to ACC for communion. On display in the sanctuary is the flagon and one cup. Over time the flagon was put in storage at the church, and ACC members found it in 1967. The church apparently sent several or all of the cups out for repair at the time of the Civil War, and they were never returned. It is unknown if this one cup is original to ACC's communion service. *Purchase record for the set is in the ACC archives*.
